<b>A</b> Almost Certain						<b>Elimination</b> is a permanent solution and should be attempted in the first instance.
<b>B</b> Likely						<b>Substitution</b> involves replacing the hazard or environmental aspect by one of lower risk.
<b>C</b> Possible						<b>Engineering</b> controls involve physical barriers or structural changes to the environment or process.
<b>D</b> Unlikely		X				<b>Administrative</b> controls reduce hazard by altering procedures and providing instructions.
<b>E</b> Rare						<b>Personal protective equipment</b> last resort or temporary control.
