Weapons instruction in the Dojo/class is a part of the curriculum for the student and is required (from 2010) for brown belt and above to pass their gradings.

All students must listen to instructions at all times.

No student is to practice in class without direct supervision.

Instructors must ensure that all participants are familiar with set rules for all weapons being taught.

Students will NOT be put at risk during instruction.

Full supervision will be maintained at all times.

All weapons are to be regularly inspected for faults or damage and if any faults or damage is found, the said equipment is to be immediately removed from service and either returned under warranty to the manufacturer or destroyed.

Students found to be irresponsible with any weapons will be immediately removed from the weapons class and provided instruction on the use of weapons in class until it is clear they understand the rules and implications of their actions
